- Relevance, interest, and value of the topic to SoCPaR 2009 attendees.
- Complementarily to the SoCPaR 2009 program provided by the other tracks.
- Completeness, clarity, and quality of the session proposal.
- Qualification of the submitter(s) to organize the workshop.
- · Likely success of the proposed session.
- · Overlap with other proposal or pre-selected activity.
